SUBJECT:

Discussion and Possible Action by the Utilities Commission of the City of Del Rio, Texas to approve the Val Verde County project named Vega Verde Water Line Project TxCDBG Contract No. 7216075

SUMMARY:

Val Verde County has a TxCDBG Grant for the project to install water mains along Vega Verde Road and service lines. In order to move the project along due to funding, Val Verde County proceeded with the purchase of materials. Plans and specifications have been submitted to the City and the project meets the TCEQ criteria for the water mains and service lines.

BACKGROUND:

Val Verde County submitted plans and specifications to the City of Del Rio, Texas for reviews. Staff from this department and the Water Department have reviewed both. Project will provide for approximately seventeen (17) new water connections. All work is in accordance with City's criteria. Construction will begin at the existing Fire Hydrant starting if the railroad tracks, where Val Verde County terminated the first portion of this project. City staff will conduct any necessary inspections.

DISCUSSION:

It is necessary for the Utilities Commission to approve the project and subsequently the project can be presented to the City Council for approval.

PROS:

This project will provide new mains and at least 17 service connections to residents of that area that presently have no service. Further, any new connections benefit the City of Del Rio, Texas with the sale of water and associated revenues. .

CONS:

City of Del Rio, Texas after completion of the project will have the standard maintenance and upkeep of the system but this is similar standard practice to taking over newly annexed areas that complete the water or wastewater projects

RECOMMENDATION:

City of Del Rio, Texas staff recommend the approval be granted by the Utilities Commission and be presented later to the City Council for action.

Fiscal impact will only be the associated maintenance standard costs on any new added systems.
